PURPOSE:

• To give non-clinical staff the option of wearing a cloth mask to work.

PROCEDURE:

- A. Type of facial mask appropriate for non-clinical staff use:
 - 1) Cotton material; double layered with a slot to be able to insert a coffee filter for extra protection. (No polyester material, beads, charms, rhinestones, etc.)
 - 2) Solid colors or patterns on cotton material okay.
 - 3) Only appropriate prints will be allowed (no offensive designs or printed material).
 - 4) No bandanas allowed as head gear or facial cover.
- B. Cleaning of facial masks used in non-clinical areas will be the responsibility of the employee. Masks must be cleaned for daily use in the non-clinical setting.
 - 1) It will take at least two masks to efficiently use a clean facial mask daily.
 - 2) Wash in HOT water, wash cycle for at least 15 minutes (the longer the better).
 - 3) Add bleach to disinfect.
 - 4) Dry in dryer OR hang to dry.

NOTE:

- A. <u>Staff in clinical areas are to use surgical and procedural masks (N95, Industrial-filtered masks, or PAPRS) provided by hospital only.</u>
- B. No home-made or privately purchased cloth facial masks allowed in clinical areas!!

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
